Hello, my name is Shannon Fenton, sister of Sgt. Joshua James Rimer of the United States Army. On July 22nd, 2009, Joshua was killed in action in Zabul, Afghanistan. We are honoring his life and the lives of all who have fallen by supporting those who have served and are still serving today.

On April 18th, 2015, we held our first Sgt. Joshua J. Rimer Memorial Walk in honor of Josh's 30th birthday. The event was a great success. With the help of people like you and the 400+ attendees, we were able to raise over \$22,000.

At this time, we are planning our second memorial walk along with a Chinese Auction, 50/50, food and bake sale.
